WASTE DISPOSAL SITE LICENSING PROVISIONS

FURTHER WASTE DISPOSAL LICENCE IN
RESPECT OF LAND AT CASTLE CEMENT (PADESWOOD)
LIMITED, PADESWOOD WORKS, NR. MOLD

This licence relates to the infilling of the remaining area of land within the works, formerly covered by Licence 102/77 which expired on 19th July, 1987.

Schedule of Conditions

1. This Licence shall enure for the benefit of Castle Cement Company Limited only and shall expire on 19th July 1997 i.e. 10 years from the date of expiry of the previous licence.
2. This Licence shall only apply to wastes which are produced within the curtilage of the Castle Cement Padeswood Works.
3. Only inert non toxic non-leachate producing wastes arising from the cement manufacturing process, including waste packaging material, off cuts of ferrous and non ferrous metals, scrap timber, plastic and paper together with inert non toxic wastes arising from on site construction works shall be deposited on the site. No materials may be deposited in containers of any description.
4. No surface burning of controlled waste shall be permitted on the site.
5. Within a period of one year from the date of issue of this Licence a 1:500 scale plan shall be submitted for approval to the Alyn and Deeside District Council clearly indicating the proposals for the final restoration of the site.
6. Upon completion of the filling operation a 1:2 embankment shall be formed adjacent to the north western boundary of the site which shall be finished at a level not exceeding 106.00m A.O.D. as indicated on Drawing 18.23/75A as submitted and approved by the Alyn and Deeside District Council.
