ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (England and Wales) REGULATIONS 2010

Dear Mr. Jones,

Following on from our recent conversation and after an audit of a selection of your Hazardous Waste Consignment notes I would like to draw your attention to the following;

A hazardous waste consignment note must be used when asbestos waste is moved from one location to another (including asbestos produced by a contractor at domestic premises).

The consignment note procedure is set out in the Hazardous Waste (Wales) Regulations 2005 as amended and must be followed by all parties in the waste movement.

Each part of the consignment note must be filled out in order, by the right person, at the right time. The information in Parts A, B, C and D of the note must not be changed after the consignor has certified it or after the waste has been removed from the premises listed in A2.

These changes make the note invalid. You may commit an offence if you accept hazardous waste if the consignment note is incorrect.

There are always risks associated with the transfer and storage of asbestos waste. Where cement bonded asbestos is not delivered direct to landfill and is stored at a transfer station, introducing double handling, cement bonded asbestos must be double-bagged or double-wrapped (if in large pieces).

Appropriately packaged asbestos waste must be taken from the delivery vehicle and placed directly into a lockable, sealed skip. Handling bags should not compromise the bag or its content. Bags must not be opened.

You should have emergency procedures to deal with non-conforming asbestos wastes that arrive at your facility. Non-conformance includes wastes received that are not properly contained in bags or skips, for example unwrapped asbestos sheets and open skips or trailers. Records must be made and kept for non-conforming wastes.

As discussed, PLEASE CEASE IMMEDIATELY pre-populating your hazardous waste consignment notes and ensure that each consignment note is filled out in order, at the correct time, by the correct person. Failure to comply with this will result in further enforcement action being taken.
