1.2.2 The total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 100,000 tonnes.

### **Schedule 3 – conditions to be added**

The following conditions are added as a result of the application made by the operator:

1.1.3 The operator shall manage and operate the activities:

- (a) in accordance with a written management system that identifies and minimises risks of pollution, including those arising from operations, maintenance, accidents, incidents, non-conformances, closures and those drawn to the attention of the operator as a result of complaints; and
- (b) using sufficient competent persons and resources.

1.1.4 Records demonstrating compliance with condition 1.1.3 shall be maintained.
