### **Waste Return Review**

A review of the 2015 and quarter 1 and 2 2016 waste returns submissions has been completed for permit number JP3997EF. Unfortunately we have not received the waste returns for quarters 3 and 4 2015 or quarters 1 and 2 2016 as required condition 4.2.2 of your permit. As a direct result of this breach of permit condition 4.2.2 a CSS score 4 has been applied.

### **Actions Required**

You are required to ensure that the missing waste returns for quarters 3, 4 2015 and quarters 1 & 2 2016 are submitted to [waste.returns@cyfoethnaturiolcymru.gov.uk](mailto:waste.returns@cyfoethnaturiolcymru.gov.uk) no later than the 10th November 2016. You must also ensure that a system is put in place to ensure that this breach of permit does not occur again in the future. A copy of the latest waste returns template has been attached to this email for your use.

Could I also take this opportunity to remind you that the waste returns for quarter 3 2016 are due to be submitted to [waste.returns@cyfoethnaturiolcymru.gov.uk](mailto:waste.returns@cyfoethnaturiolcymru.gov.uk) no later than the 31st October 2016. Please remember to use your permit number (JP3997EF) and not your EAWML number on the form and in box 2.2 please enter your site type as SR2010 No4: Mobile Plant for land-spreading.
