Natural Resources Wales considers that the following condition of the environmental permit is being contravened:

Permit condition 1.1.1. *The operator shall manage and operate the activities in accordance with a written management system that identifies and minimises risks of pollution, including those arising from operations, maintenance, accidents, incidents, non-conformances, closure and those drawn to the attention of the operator as a result of complaints.*

Condition 1.5.5 of the Environmental Management system stipulates that the max duration of storage of mixed waste on site is 6 months

Because the operator has routinely failed to comply with condition 1.5.5 of the Environmental Management system that stipulates that the max duration of storage of mixed waste on site is 6 months.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the date specified in order to remedy the contravention.
