Schedule

Daily tonnages

1. Section 1.5.5 of your Environment Management System (EMS) states that the maximum amount of waste to be accepted is both 2,000 tonnes per day (in the text) and 4,000 tonnes per day (Table 1). Please confirm which is correct and amend as necessary.
2. Sections 1.5.5 and 1.5.6 of your EMS; table 1 states you will accept a maximum amount of 2,000 tonnes per day of co-mingled recyclables, but table 2 gives a maximum storage capacity for this waste of 1,000 tonnes at any one time. Please explain how this would work. If it is an error please correct and amend as necessary.

Fire

3. Section 3.3 – of your EMS does not contain adequate information on how waste will be stored to reduce fire risk and/or minimize impact of a fire (e.g. volume of waste to be stored in each storage area). Please amend as necessary.
4. The Fire Contingency Response and Environmental Incident Plan is not adequate considering the large volumes of combustible material that you are proposing to store on site (i.e. paper and card) and is not in accordance with section 9 of TGN7.01.
5. Please provide the Fire prevention and Management Plan as described in section 5.2.1 of your EMS and ensure it meets the relevant guidance as set out in *How to comply with your environmental permit*.

Odour

6. In Section 4.5.1 of your EMS you have stated that “the range of waste types accepted at the site present a very low risk of odour nuisance”. Given that the wastes you have proposed include food and drink packaging (the 15 01 codes) and mixed municipal waste (20 03 01), can you please explain how you have come to the conclusion that there would be “a very low risk of odour nuisance” and detail any measures you will have in place in deal with these specific wastes.

Please note that we may ask for a dedicated odour management plan to be produced in line with horizontal guidance note H4 Odour depending on your responses to this request for information.

Site condition report

7. We have been unable to assess your Site Condition Report as you have not supplied the “Ground Contamination Investigation and Assessment” (April 2014 – E-Geo Solutions Ltd). Please do so.
