The following interpretation is amended in Schedule 4 of the permit:

“*Waste code*” means the six digit code referable to a type of waste in accordance with the list of wastes established by Commission Decision 2000/532/EC as amended from time to time (the ‘List of Wastes Decision’) and in relation to hazardous waste, includes the asterisk.

### **Schedule 3 – conditions to be added**

The following conditions are added following a Natural Resources Wales initiated variation.

#### **WEEE treatment**

- 2.5.2 The storage (including temporary storage) and treatment of WEEE shall be carried out in accordance with the technical requirements of Annex VIII of the WEEE Directive.
- 2.5.3 Equipment shall be provided to record the weight of untreated WEEE accepted at, and components and materials leaving the site.

The following interpretations are added to Schedule 4 of the permit:

*“WEEE”* means waste electrical and electronic equipment.

*“WEEE Directive”* means Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4th July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE).
