Any more accurate information on the matters for notification under Part A.	Notification part A raised as CO was very close to daily average ELV at 78.27 mg/Nm <sup>3</sup> @8% O2 dry gas. Verification process using CEMS database showed the daily average limit was exceeded at 81.20 mg/Nm <sup>3</sup> @8% O2 dry gas.
Measures taken, or intended to be taken, to prevent a recurrence of the incident	No instrumentation issue or process variation was found that might have caused the high daily average. More specifically there was a high uncorrected CO reading on CEMS of 753.19 mg/Nm <sup>3</sup> that appeared to freeze between 0757 and 0841. Enviro Technology couldn't find a cause of this high constant reading and it did not re-occur in November. All their operational checks were satisfactory on 14 <sup>th</sup> November. Further investigation will take place if there are similar events in the future.
