Hi Kate

I was provided your name by Eirian MacDonald with regard to the consolidation of waste permits at Ferryboat Close in Swansea. The City and County of Swansea currently operates three adjoining permitted facilities on the road:

- EP3399VE – Recycling Depot (with exemption for aggregate crushing)
- QB3032RW – Baling Plant Waste Transfer Station
- QB3031RE – Baling Plant Household Waste Recycling Centre

We are also going to commence the transfer of a permit from a partner contractor into our operation for a fourth facility on the road: SP3998VE, currently operated by United Recycled Aggregates Ltd.

I have attached a rough pdf showing the relative locations of each permit/facility. In short, we would like to amend how we utilise the areas/facilities. We would like to utilise the area of the EP3399VE permit as an extension of the Household Waste Recycling Centre and move the Recycling Depot operation to the area of the SP3998VE permit. Eirian explained that a permit consolidation may be the easiest approach. I understand that we may not be able to consolidate the SP3998VE permit until we have undertaken the operator transfer. Given the timescale in which we would like to utilise the additional HWRC area we may chose not to consolidate the SP3998VE area.

Can you let me know the feasibility of, and potential timescales for this consolidation? If there is anything else you need please let me know.
