RE: Crane Cross Civic Amenity and Recycling Centre NB3193HN/A001

I had the pleasure of visiting your Crane Cross Civic amenity site yesterday and was impressed by quality of design and construction. Although work is not yet complete I am confident that you are on track to open on March 30th 2015.

It is unlikely that your permit application will have been determined by that date. It is an offence under regulation 38 of the Environmental Permitting Regulations to operate a waste management facility without a permit, however there is no reason for Natural Resources Wales to take action pending determination providing the following are observed:

1. There is no harm to human health, pollution of the environment or serious detriment to the amenities of the area.
2. The site is operated in accordance with the conditions of your Winsel permit.

Should your application be refused, we would need to ensure the site is cleared under notice of waste in a timely fashion.

In reaching this decision I have taken account of our delay in processing your application, the consequence to the public purse of you not being able to meet your grant conditions and the job opportunity cost of losing the sale of the plot you are vacating.

Again I would like to congratulate you on this project and the example set to the local waste industry.
