Odour Management Plan

In preparing this document, guidance notes H4 Odour Management , as part of the How to comply with your environmental permit, has been considered in detail and the relevant sections incorporated as necessary.

The application for the waste transfer station, incorporating a schedule of permitted wastes, does not identify any wastes which have a propensity to produce mal odours. Nevertheless this document contains details of the monitoring procedures incorporated into the environmental management system to ensure that whatever the circumstances, checks for odours at the site boundaries are conducted and the results recorded in the site log / diary.

The site management procedure will assess the impact of any possible odours using complaints and the results of daily / regular sniff testing at the site boundary and at the reception area inside the main transfer station building.

The Environmental Management System includes a complaints procedure which records the reasons, time and day of complaint etc. which will be used for all complaints from any source.

Although sniff testing at the site boundary and in the vicinity of the waste acceptance area are carried out daily, site managers will, during the regular operational management function, identify any mal odours and instigate the provisions of this Odour Management Plan.

Any reports of a mal odour incident or complaints of such will be recorded and the information passed on to the local NRW Environment Officer.
