## Schedule

### Waste types

In reference to the document “010 waste activities” and “non technical summary” both received 03/03/17, you stated that the proposed activity is to take “gully and wet well waste”. However, you have applied to take the following three waste types that do not appear to meet the purpose of the activity you are applying for:

17 05 04	soil and stones other than those mentioned in 17 05 03
17 05 06	dredging spoil other than those mentioned in 17 05 05
17 09 04	mixed construction and demolition wastes other than those mentioned in 17 09 01, 17 09 02 and 17 09 03

#### Action:

1. Please explain these codes are required and what (if any) treatment you propose it goes through.

Furthermore, use of a “99” waste code is a last resort where there are no other suitable codes available to describe that waste type. We require to know what you intend to accept under the codes so we can ensure it is the most appropriate code, and also assess the risk associated with the description of said waste.

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## **Odour Management Plan**

## **Clarification on storage limits and times**

In reference to “Management system summary” received 06/03/17, “Odour management plan” received 08/03/17 and “*Fire Management Plan*” 07/03/17, there are contradictions in the amount of waste to be stored at site at any one time and the maximum amount of time.

The former document says 60 tonnes for upto 2 days, the latter two documents atates 200 tonnes for upto a week.
