**Request for Permit Variation (EPR/UB3998FB)**

I have attached to this letter relevant application forms to vary a waste operation permit (normal variation) for Celtic Recycling Ltd at their site in Pyle, together with relevant WAMITAB certificates of registration and continuing competence proof documents. Payment has been arranged separately.

Discussions (via email) with Holly Noble (Team Leader – Permitting Section) have agreed that under the circumstances of the proposed variation, costs will be worked out on an 'abatement' basis and the relevant email correspondence has been put on file.

No new waste streams will be treated and total tonnages will remain the same; the new process will simply allow for a higher recycling rate by facilitating materials separation in line with the principles of the circular economy and in a way that was not previously possible with existing processes. A small percentage of the total waste streams currently treated on site will be diverted to the new process to increase recycling and landfill diversion.

Information requirements of Appendix 2 of form C4 have not been affected by the addition of the new process (e.g. waste types and amounts, and procedures for waste pre-acceptance, waste acceptance and waste storage remain the same as on the existing permit, and as approved in a previous variation/ consolidation exercise).
