Table S2.1 Permitted waste types and quantities

<b>Table S2.1 Permitted waste types and quantities for storage</b>	
<b>Maximum quantity</b>	The maximum quantity for waste to be accepted on site shall not exceed 25,000 tonnes per year.
<b>Exclusions</b>	Notwithstanding the permitted waste types, wastes having any of the following characteristics shall not be accepted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- hazardous waste;</li><li>- wastes which are odour producing or likely to be odorous; or</li><li>- wastes in liquid form.</li></ul>
