**ENFORCEMENT NOTICE TO TAKE SPECIFIED STEPS IN RELATION TO A

Natural Resources Wales considers that the following condition of the environmental permit is being contravened:

2.1.1 The operator is only authorised to carry out the operations specified in table 2.1 below ("the activities").

Table 2.1 Activities	
Description of activities	Limits of activities
R13: storage of wastes pending the operations numbered R3 and R5. R3: recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents. R5: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.	Treatment of wastes listed in table 2.3 consisting only of sorting, separation, screening, crushing and blending of waste for recovery as a soil, soil substitute or aggregate. Secure storage of wastes listed in table 2.3 pending treatment. Storage of wastes listed in table 2.4 shall not exceed 10,000 tonnes in total at any one time. All other wastes shall not exceed 40,000 tonnes in total at any one time. No more than 75,000 tonnes of waste shall be treated per year.

Because the mixed waste stockpile is not a waste type listed in table 2.3 it cannot be treated under permit number EPR/YP3795VF. As this mixed waste stockpile cannot be treated under permit number EPR/YP3795VF, the mixed waste stockpile cannot be stored under description of activity R13: storage of wastes pending the operations numbered R3 and R5.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the date specified in order to remedy the contravention.

General

2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.

Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(1)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

The required documents are:

- A statement of the grounds of appeal
- A copy of any relevant application
- A copy of any relevant environmental permit
- A copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator
- A copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal
- A statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying The Planning Inspectorate in writing and sending a copy of that notification to Natural Resources Wales. Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from The Planning Inspectorate detailed above.

Legislation note

In this document "Natural Resources Wales" means the Natural Resources Body for Wales established by Article 3 of the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Establishment) Order 2012. On 01 April 2013 the Natural Resources Body for Wales (Functions) Order 2013 transferred the relevant functions of the Countryside Council for Wales, and functions of the Environment Agency and the Forestry Commission in Wales to the Natural Resources Body for Wales.

2.1.1	The mixed waste stockpile¹ shall be removed from Unit 10, Tank Farm Road, Llandarcy, Skewen, Neath Port Talbot, SA10 6EN. On 31 October 2017, 31 January 2018 and 30 April 2018 evidence of the following shall be provided to Natural Resources Wales: ➤ tonnages of waste from the mixed waste from the stockpile¹ that has been removed, ➤ estimates of the tonnage of the mixed waste stockpile¹ that remains ➤ an update on the work being undertaken to facilitate the removal of mixed waste from Unit 10, Tank Farm Road, Llandarcy, Skewen, Neath Port Talbot, SA10 6EN The mixed waste stockpile¹ shall be removed by a registered waste carrier The mixed waste stockpile¹ shall be taken to a site permitted to accept the waste. Duty of care controlled waste transfer notes shall be retained for inspection by Natural Resources Wales upon removal of each load of the mixed waste. ¹ The mixed waste stockpile is shaded red on the attached plan – GD1.	4 June 2018
