Natural Resources Wales considers that the following condition of the environmental permit is being contravened:

2.1.1 The operator is only authorised to carry out the operations specified in table 2.1 below ("the activities").

<p>R13: storage of wastes pending the operations numbered R3 and R5.</p> <p>R3: recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents.</p> <p>R5: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.</p>	<p>Treatment of wastes listed in table 2.3 consisting only of sorting, separation, screening, crushing and blending of waste for recovery as a soil, soil substitute or aggregate.</p> <p>Secure storage of wastes listed in table 2.3 pending treatment.</p> <p>Storage of wastes listed in table 2.4 shall not exceed 10,000 tonnes in total at any one time.</p> <p>All other wastes shall not exceed 40,000 tonnes in total at any one time.</p> <p>No more than 75,000 tonnes of waste shall be treated per year.</p>

Because the mixed waste stockpile (area shaded red on plan GD1) contains waste types not listed in table 2.3 it cannot be stored and/or treated under permit number EPR/YP3795VF.

You are required to take the steps set out in Schedule 1 by the date specified in order to remedy the contravention.

## **Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 Regulation 36**

### **Notes:**

#### **General**

1. Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Regulation 38(3) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 and may result in legal action being taken against you.
2. Without prejudice to the requirements of this notice, failure to comply with a condition of an environmental permit is an offence and may result in legal action being taken against you.
3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

#### **Appeal provisions**

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(2)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010. Notice of appeal must be made within two months of the date of this notice. An appeal does not affect the requirements of this notice.

At the same time you must send a copy of the appeal notice and documents to us.

The required documents are:

a statement of the grounds of appeal;  
a copy of any relevant application;  
a copy of any relevant environmental permit;  
a copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator;  
a copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal; and  
a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying Welsh Ministers in writing and sending a copy of that notification to us.

Further information about making an appeal and the forms that you will need are available from the Environmental Protection Division.
