The purpose of the inspection was to assess the compliance of S L Plant Hire with Environmental Permit EPR/TB3093HA.

On arriving at the site we found the gates to be open but no sign of any personnel. Natural Resources Wales would recommend that some kind of site sign be erected detailing who can be contacted in the event of an incident.

General Waste Storage

A walk around the site was undertaken. All material present appeared to be within permit conditions and segregated by type. There was no evidence of waste escaping via the site boundary.

Environmental Permit and Environment Management System

The copy of the Environment Management System held on file by Natural Resources Wales is dated July 2014. As this is a live, working document it is recommended that updates be made every 2-4 years in order to ensure the document reflects the current operations and management. We would also recommend that copies of this document along with your Environmental Permit are kept on site.

WAMITAB

During the last inspection of the site (16.06.16) it was noted there was no evidence of a WAMITAB qualification having been achieved. A check of the WAMITAB database undertaken by Natural Resources Wales has shown that the qualification remains out of date.

Condition 1.1.1 of your environmental permit states;

"The operator shall manage and operate the activities:

(a) in accordance with a written management system that identifies and minimises risk of pollution, including those arising from operations, maintenance, accidents, incidents, non-conformances, closure and those drawn to the attention of the operator as a result of complaints; and

(b) using sufficient competent persons and resources."

This is a breach of Condition 1.1.1 and has been scored a Category 3 breach (A non-compliance which could have a minor environmental effect) under C1 General Management - Staff competency/training.

In order to become compliant with this condition, please ensure that a WAMITAB course is booked onto and the qualification achieved as soon as possible. Please also provide a copy of the certificate to Natural Resources Wales.

Waste Returns

A Compliance Assessment Report (CAR) Form was issued to the site on the 14th October 2016 (CAR_NRW0026471). This CAR form was issued following a review of the waste returns which highlighted that the site had failed to submit any waste returns for the year 2016. A Category 4 non-compliance was also recorded.

Condition 4.2.2 of your environmental permit states;

"Within one month of the end of each quarter, the operator shall submit to Natural Resources Wales using the form made available for the purpose, the information specified on the form relating to the site and the waste accepted and removed from it during the previous quarter".

This is a breach of Condition 4.2.2 and has now been scored a Category 3 breach (A non-compliance which could have a minor environmental effect) under G4 Monitoring and records - Reporting and notification.

In order to become compliant with this condition, please submit any outstanding waste returns and put in place procedures to ensure that all future returns are completed and submitted in time. Please be aware that even if no waste has been accepted during a quarter you are still required to submit a NIL return.

The required timescales for submissions are below;

Quarterly Returns Period	Return Submission Deadline
Q1 - 1st January to 31st March	30th April
Q2 - 1st April to 30th June	31st July
Q3 - 1st July to 30th September	31st October
Q4 - 1st October to 31st December	31st January

Failure to meet future return deadlines may result in escalation of our scoring category for such a breach and may also result in further action.
