The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

Addition of waste codes 16 01 03 (end-of-life tyres) and 17 01 07 (mixtures of concrete, bricks, tiles and ceramics other than those mentioned in 17 01 06) to licensed waste types accepted at this site.

20 02 03 (other non-biodegradable wastes) was not added to the permit because the site is already permitted to accept waste under this code. Rubble waste can be accepted under code 20 02 03 already, therefore the requested change in relation to this code is not necessary.

Description of activities	Limits of activities

D14: Repackaging of waste prior to the waste being submitted to any of the operations listed in paragraphs 1 to 13 of this Part of this Schedule	Waste must be treated on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.
D9: Physico-chemical treatment of waste not listed elsewhere in this Part of this Schedule which results in final compounds or mixtures which are discarded by means of any of the operations listed in paragraphs 1 to 12 of this Part of this Schedule (for example, evaporation, drying, calcination)	No more than a total of 100 units of waste vehicle tyres (intact) (waste code 16 01 03) shall be stored at the site at any one time.
R3: Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents, including composting and other biological transformation processes	All waste vehicle tyres must be securely stored.
R4: Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds	
R5: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials
