Good morning Robert,

Thank you for the e-mail and update. In response to your query:

1. According to our mapping system the site does not lie within a GPZ.
2. I agree that site facility remains A11. I presume operations on site in principle will generally remain the same, with RDF production included in the process. This means the site will still process mixed loads of wastes for the purpose of removing recyclable materials and have residual waste sent to landfill, therefore A16 would not be suitable.

Afternoon Rhys,

I tried to ring earlier and left a message with one of your colleagues. We are making good progress drafting the permit variation application for Gwynedd Skip Hire. Following discussions with them they have decided to opt to vary to a bespoke waste operation with RDF production kept below the IED thresholds for now. Have confirmed with permitting support that this would be a standard variation.

Taking this into consideration we are compiling an OPRA profile for the site, and just need confirmation on a couple of items prior to completion. Can you confirm the following:

1. Assume the site is on an aquifer but can you confirm if within a GPZ? Difficult to locate this information on the NRW website, and not available anymore on the EA site. Have requested the information from NRW Data distribution but don't really want to wait 20 working days for a response
2. Have referenced the site as an A11 activity – 'Household, commercial and industrial waste transfer station'. Can you confirm this is correct?

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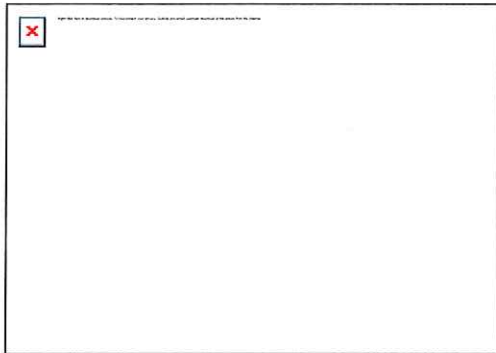
