Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

Schedule 1 of the Environmental Permitting Regulations was updated by the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 to reflect the implementation of the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) into England and Wales. Following this, Natural Resources Wales has varied Table 1.1.1 of the permit to include limits which the operator must operate below to remain a waste facility, resulting from the introduction of the Industrial Emissions Directive.

The site technically has the capacity to operate above the threshold limits detailed within the IED, specifically S5.6A(1)(a), temporary storage of hazardous waste with a total capacity exceeding 50 tonnes, however, they have chosen to put physical measures in place to operate below the threshold to remain permitted as a waste facility. Therefore, Natural Resources Wales has included these physical limits within the permit to incorporate them as an enforceable permit condition.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

R13: Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced).	<p>Receipt, storage and transfer only of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Wastes specified in Appendix C: Waste Types Revision 2 of the Working Plan. <p>Temporary storage of hazardous waste, pending any of the activities listed in Sections 5.1, 5.2 and 5.3 of the environmental permitting regulations shall not exceed a total capacity of 50 tonnes. This includes any underground storage of hazardous waste but does not include temporary storage pending collection of waste generated on site.</p> <p>Storage of wastes during transfer loading operations onto or from ships shall be carried out in accordance with the measures also specified in Appendix D of Revision 2 of the Working plan.</p> <p>Maximum total storage capacity on the site at any one time shall not exceed the maximum tonnage specified in section 1.1iii) of Appendix D of the Working Plan and Appendix G of the Working Plan.</p> <p>Storage areas for keeping wastes on the site prior to transfer loading onto the Wharf site shall be within the specified areas outlined in Appendix A 1.3: Operational Site Layout Plan of the Working Plan.</p> <p>All hazardous waste must be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. stored on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage with provision of spillage collection facilities and, where appropriate decanters and cleanser degreasers;2. stored in areas provided with a weatherproof covering where appropriate or in containers providing a weatherproof covering where appropriate.
