Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

This notice is to reduce the waste quantity accepted for disposal at the landfill site down to nil tonnes during any one calendar month and zero tonnes in any one year. This is permitted because the site is not in definitive closure and as such shall remain in Table 3 for charging purposes.

Existing condition reads:

B PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED WASTES

B.1 Permitted types and quantities of waste

- (b) the total quantity of wastes accepted monthly shall not exceed 20,000 tonnes and an annual limit not exceeding 74,999 tonnes shall apply. For the purpose of this condition, all vehicles discharging wastes for the purposes of construction of cell liners, bunds or caps and for the purposes of the reconstruction of the surface of the site shall not count towards this total however, all such loads shall be recorded in accordance with the requirements of condition D1.

Amended condition reads:

- (b) the total quantity of wastes accepted for disposal at the site monthly shall be nil and an annual limit of zero tonnes shall apply.

APPENDIX 1 – PERMITTED WASTE TYPES

Existing condition reads:

No liquid wastes are permitted to be deposited in the site.

The total maximum permitted quantity of wastes consisting of the waste types, listed below in table 1, shall be not exceed 20,000 tonnes in any one calendar month and 74,999 tonnes in any one year.

The remainder of Appendix 1 shall remain unchanged.

Amended condition reads:

No wastes shall be deposited in the site for the purpose of disposal.

The total maximum permitted quantity of wastes consisting of the waste types, listed below in table 1, shall be nil tonnes in any one calendar month and zero tonnes in any one year.

The remainder of Appendix 1 shall remain unchanged.
