The following condition to Waste Management Licence number 174/93 shall be modified:

B PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED WASTES

B.1 Permitted types and quantities of waste

Existing conditions reads:

- (b) *The total quantity of wastes accepted monthly shall not exceed 20,000 tonnes. For the purpose of this condition, all vehicles discharging wastes for the purposes of construction of cell liners, bunds or caps and for the purposes of the reconstruction of the surface of the site road shall not count towards this total however, all such loads shall be recorded in accordance with the requirements of Condition D1.*

Condition shall read:

- (b) The total quantity of wastes accepted monthly shall not exceed 20,000 tonnes and an annual limit not exceeding 74,999 tonnes shall apply. For the purpose of this condition, all vehicles discharging wastes for the purposes of construction of cell liners, bunds or caps and for the purposes of the reconstruction of the surface of the site road shall not count towards this total however, all such loads shall be recorded in accordance with the requirements of Condition D1.

APPENDIX 1 – PERMITTED WASTE TYPES

Existing conditions reads:

No liquid wastes are permitted to be deposited in the site.

The total maximum permitted quantity of waste consisting of the waste types listed below, in Table 1, shall not exceed 20 000 tonnes in any one calendar month.

Condition shall read:

No liquid wastes are permitted to be deposited in the site.

The total maximum permitted quantity of wastes consisting of the waste types, listed below in table 1, shall not exceed 20,000 tonnes in any one calendar month and 74,999 tonnes in any one year.

The remainder of Appendix 1 shall remain unchanged

RIGHTS OF APPEAL

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the National Assembly for Wales,

- a** an application for a modification of the conditions to a licence is rejected; or
- b** the conditions of a licence are modified;

then the applicant for the modification of the licence or, as the case may be, the holder of the licence may appeal from the decision to the National Assembly for Wales.

Therefore if you feel aggrieved by the decision or any of the conditions to the licence as modified you may obtain the appropriate form on which to give notice of an appeal from:-

You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any of the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency (at the address below). You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the National Assembly for Wales may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.
