NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE

WHEREAS on 21 July 1993 the Alyn & Deeside District Council granted to you a Waste Disposal Licence, now to be treated as a Waste Management Licence, Reference Number ~~174/93~~ relating to Standard Landfill site, Spencers Ind Estate, Off Liverpool Rd, Buckley subject to the conditions set out therein and in any subsequent Modifications.

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that the Environment Agency ("the Agency") modifies the said conditions as follows:-

The following Conditions attached to Waste Management Licence Reference Number 174/93 shall be deleted,

Condition Number(s): D1, D3, D4 and Appendix 5

and the attached Conditions, Waste Management Licence Reference Number 174/93 shall be substituted.

New Condition No: D1

D1.1 A record shall be kept of all wastes received and of all materials (wastes and recovered materials) removed from the site. The records shall include the following for each vehicle load of waste/material.

for waste received

- (a) origin of waste
- (b) date received
- (c) quantities in tonnes received and waste type as specified in Condition No: B1
- (d) nature of the waste (solid, liquid or sludge)

for waste/material removed

- (e) date removed
- (f) quantities in tonnes removed and waste and/or material type
- (g) destination of waste and/or materials removed
- (h) nature of the waste and/or materials (solid, liquid or sludge)

D1.2 A summary of the information, including nil returns shall be submitted to the Agency, in a format required by the Agency. Summaries shall be for each quarter of the financial year and shall be submitted to the Agency within one month of the end of each quarter.

New Condition No. D3: Analyses of Soils and Other Wastes

D3(a) A record shall be kept of all analyses of soils and other wastes carried out in accordance with the requirements of Condition C1(b). This record shall include the results of all such analyses. The record of each such analysis shall include a summary interpretation thereof.

(D3b) A copy of the record of all analyses carried out in accordance with the requirements of Condition D3(a) including any summary interpretations thereof shall be forwarded to the Environment Agency in writing within 14 (fourteen) days of the analysis results having been received by the licence holder.

New Condition No. D4: Monitoring of Surface Waters, Groundwater and Leachate

- D4 (a) A record shall be kept of all conductivity measurements and all analyses of samples of
- (i) surface waters arising from the site and in watercourses adjacent to the site;
 - (ii) groundwater and
 - (iii) leachate
- In accordance with the requirements of Conditions 13, 14 and 15 respectively. The record of each such analysis shall include a summary interpretation of the results.
- D4(b) A copy of the record of all conductivity measurements and analyses of water samples carried out in accordance with the requirements Condition D4(a) including any summary interpretations thereof shall be forwarded to the Environment Agency in writing within 14 (fourteen) days of
- (i) the conductivity measurements having been taken and/or
 - ii) analysis results having been received by the licence holder.

New Condition No. D5: Measurements of Landfill Gas Concentration

- D5(a) A record shall be kept of all measurements of concentrations of flammable gas, carbon dioxide and oxygen carried out in accordance with the requirements of Condition 16.
- D5(b) Any copy of the record of the measurements of concentrations of gases made in accordance with the requirements of Condition D5(a) shall be submitted in writing to the Environment Agency within 7 (seven) days of the measurements being taken.

New Condition No. D6: Measurements of Site Levels and Remaining Volume

- D6(a) A record shall be kept of the site levels relative to Ordnance Datum and of the remaining volume to be landfilled in all unfinished areas of the site. This record shall be updated at regular intervals and in any case not less frequently than once every year.
- D6(b) A copy of any measurements taken or calculations made in accordance with the requirements of Condition D6(a) shall be submitted to the Environment Agency within one calendar month of the measurements being taken.

New Condition No. D7: Inspection of Records

- D7 All records required to be kept under Conditions D1, D3, D4, D5 and D6 of this licence must be made available to any authorised representative of the Environment Agency for inspection at any reasonable time.
