This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

This is a Regulator led variation to move the site into definitive closure and aftercare phase. This variation replaces the existing conditions relating to the operating techniques, to include a closure report into the permit and to add a condition requiring the operator to maintain a closure and aftercare management plan. An improvement condition is also included for the operator to propose additional groundwater compliance limits for downgradient boreholes.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

Schedule 1 – conditions to be deleted

A2 Operation of the Site

The site shall be operated in accordance with the methods of operation described in the accepted Working Plan so as to prevent nuisance or detriment to the amenity, risk of water pollution, danger to public health, nuisance or detriment to the amenity.

The accepted Working Plan shall form part of this licence, however, in the event of any proposals or details in the Working Plan conflict with these licence conditions, the licence conditions will prevail.

A5 Working Plan

For the purpose of this licence the Working Plan shall consist of the latest issue or modification of the Working Plan which has been accepted in writing by the Waste Regulation Authority.

Acceptance by the authority of the Working Plan shall not relieve the licence holder of his responsibility to ensure that any or all of the following do not occur:

- (i) Pollution of the environment
- (ii) Harm to human health
- (iii) Serious detriment to the amenities

A6 Modifications to and Acceptance of Working Plan

The current issue of the Working Plan shall not be revised, altered or otherwise modified unless:-

- (i) A copy of the proposed revision, alteration or other modification has been submitted to the Waste Regulation Authority in writing.
- (ii) The proposed revision, alteration or other modification has been accepted by the Waste Regulation Authority in writing within two months of the date of its submission for consideration or any greater time limit which is agreed between the licence holder and the Waste Regulation Authority.

Schedule 3 – conditions to be added

The following conditions are added following a Natural Resources Wales initiated variation:

A2 Operating techniques

- (a) The activities shall, subject to the conditions of this permit, be operated using the techniques and in the manner described in the documentation specified in table A2.1, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Natural Resources Wales.
- (b) If notified by Natural Resources Wales that the activities are giving rise to pollution, the operator shall submit to Natural Resources Wales for approval within the period specified, a revision of any plan or other documentation ("plan") specified in table A2.1 or otherwise required under this permit which identifies and minimises the risks of pollution relevant to that plan, and shall implement the approved revised plan in place of the original from the date of approval, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Natural Resources Wales.

A3 Improvement programme

- a) The operator shall complete the improvements specified in table A3.1 by the date specified in that table unless otherwise agreed in writing by Natural Resources Wales.
- b) Except in the case of an improvement which consists only of a submission to Natural Resources Wales, the operator shall notify Natural Resources Wales within 14 days of completion of each improvement.

IC1	The operator shall propose additional groundwater compliance limits for downgradient boreholes GW2 and GW3 for chloride and at least one other substance that is representative of the compounds present in the leachate. These shall be submitted to Natural Resources Wales for written approval. This condition shall only be discharged once Natural Resources Wales have provided written approval.	Within 12 months of variation issue.

A5 Closure and aftercare

- a) The operator shall maintain a closure and aftercare management plan.
