NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF DISPOSAL LICENCE NUMBER 174/93

WHEREAS on 21st June 1993 a disposal licence was issued to AD Waste Ltd relating to the landfilling of controlled wastes at Standard Landfill Site, Buckley, Minute Number 4 dated 10th November 1992 refers, subject to the conditions set out therein.

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that the Alyn and Deeside District Council modifies the said conditions as follows:-

Delete Licence condition F1 and substitute new Licence condition F1 attached.

F1 OPENING HOURS

The site shall be permitted to be open for the receipt, removal, deposit and/or handling of all wastes permitted by condition B1 during the hours specified below:-

Monday to Friday	07:30 to 20:00 Hours
Saturday	07:30 to 20:00 Hours

Additionally, wastes produced only on civic amenity sites are permitted to be deposited during the hours specified below:-

Sunday	07:30 to 20:00 Hours
Bank Holidays	07:30 to 20:00 Hours

No waste shall be deposited outside of these hours except:-

- i) During the last three weeks of December and the first two weeks of January the site will be permitted to open on certain Sundays from 07:30 to 20:00 hours for the receipt and deposit of Household Waste collected by the Contract Works Department of Alyn and Deeside District Council, the dates of these Sundays to be approved in writing by the Waste Regulation Authority at least two weeks prior to the first affected Sunday.
- ii) In the case of an emergency and with the prior consent of the Waste Regulation Authority.

No waste shall be deposited during the hours covered by official lighting-up times (as published by the Science and Engineering Research Council) unless adequate lighting of at least 50 lux is provided and is in use in accordance with the Working Plan. This lighting must be independent of the vehicle lighting.

Any lighting provided shall be screened or directed to ensure that neighbouring properties are not adversely affected by the light during operating hours.
