BX4666IZ Minor change request

In response to email dated 24th July 2019, please be advised that we seek to obtain a minor change to Permit No.BX4666IZ under Condition 1.5.

The Special Materials (SM1) area of the Optical Shops within the St Asaph production facility proposes to replace two semi-automated Rogers and Clark Optical Polishing machines with an OptoTech CNC high-speed polishing machine (SPO 80 CNC). The SPO80 has the functionality to undertake the work previously completed by the two redundant machines.

The replacement machine is fully enclosed and with no changes in terms of chemicals used, no new environmental emissions to those currently detailed in the permit are predicted. We do anticipate having a reduction in environment impacts particularly those associated with a reduction in energy consumption, process chemicals usage and subsequent waste production.

The redundant Rogers and Clarke polishers have been hand cleaned in readiness for collection and disposal by Spencer Industrial Ltd. Their preferred disposal route is:

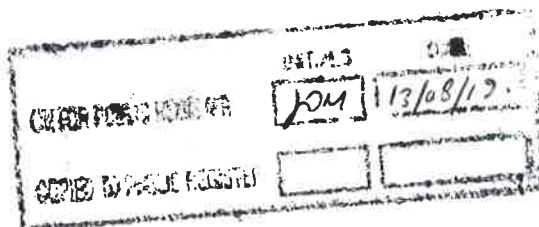
The machines will be brought complete, back to our depot, assessed, be broken down and dismantled, sorted into the various metal components and go collectively with our metals for recycling, some to smelters and some to the docks for export, any non-recyclable elements (if any), will be disposed of in the correct manner.

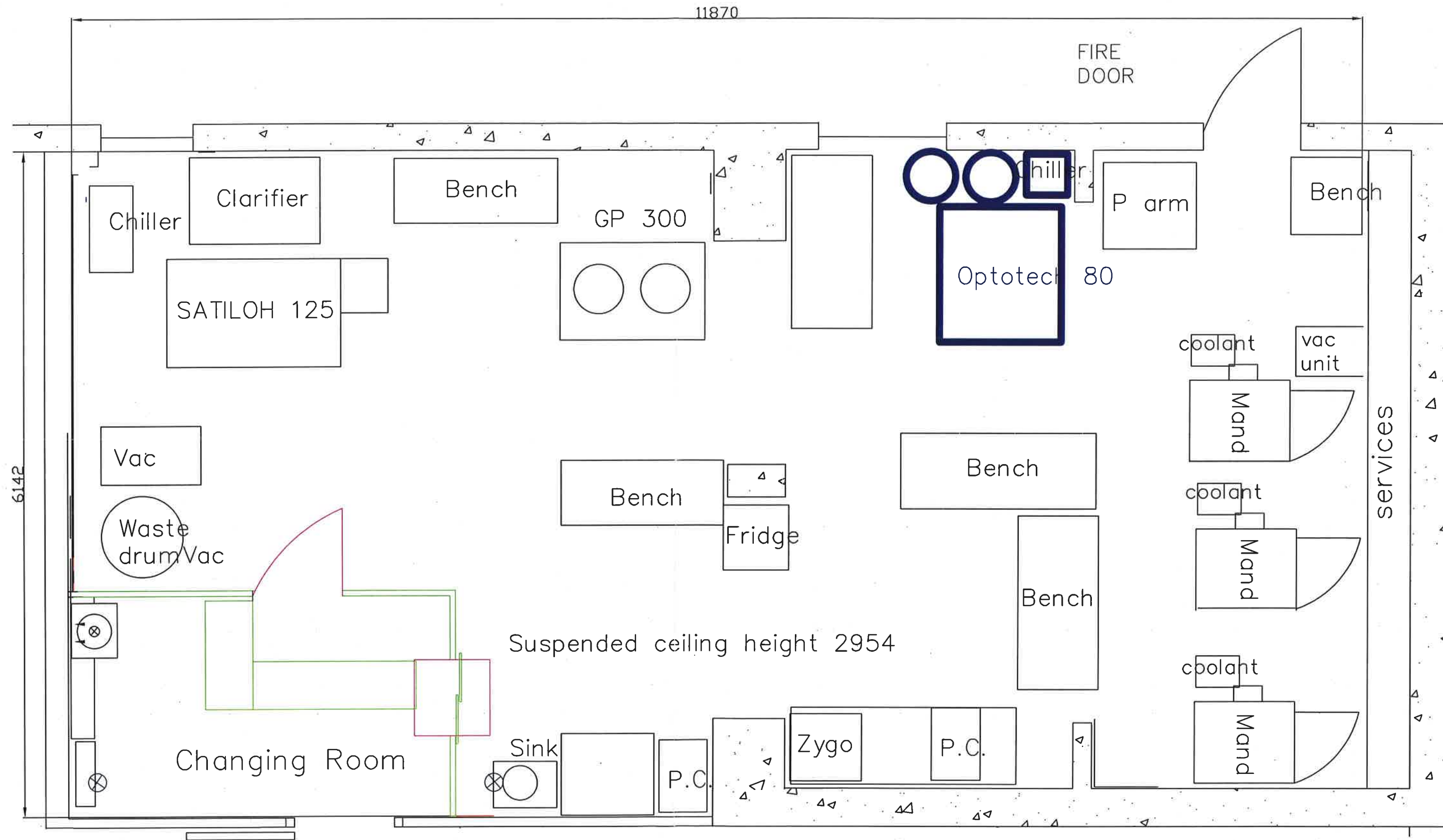

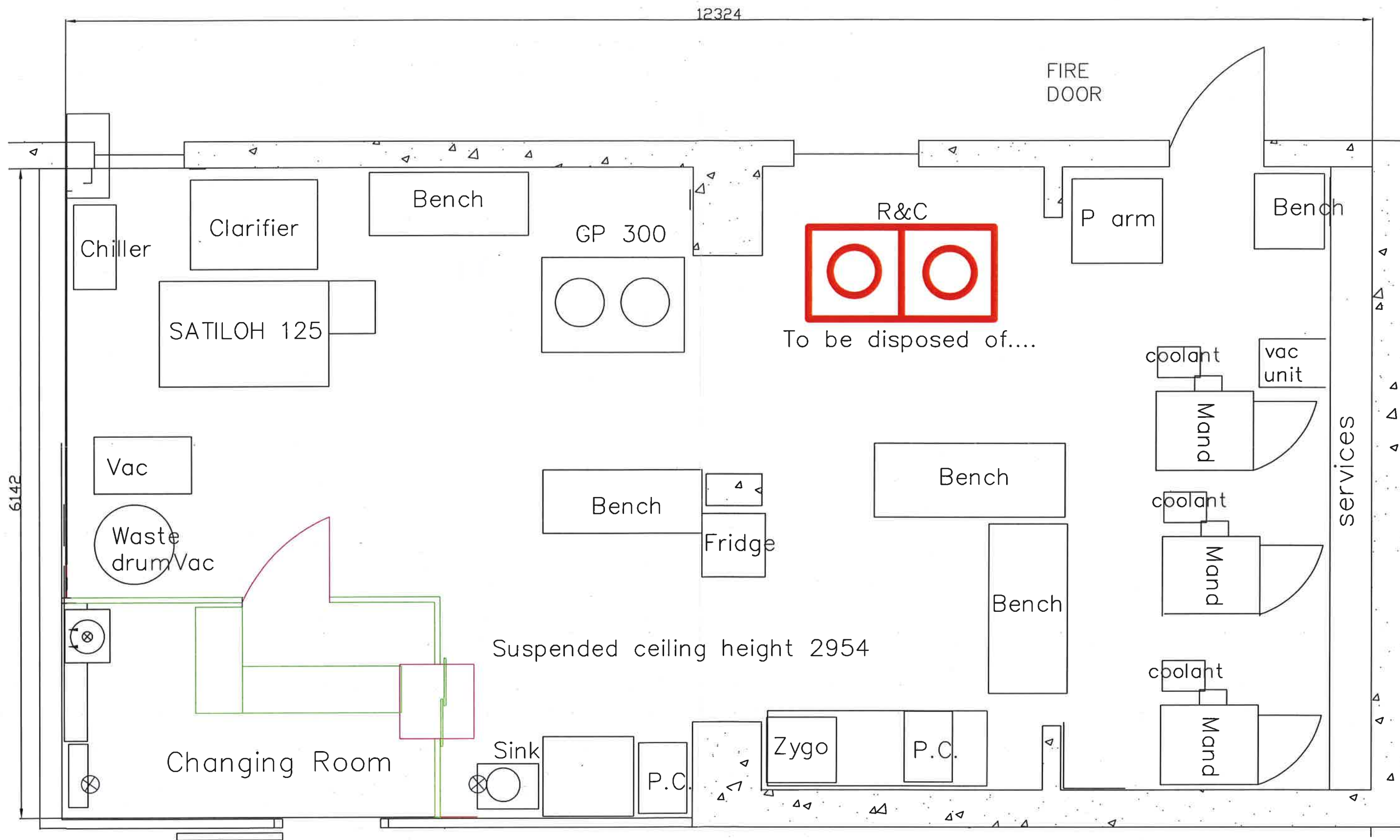
