We are in the process of submitting a Band 1 Marine Licence Application for sand re-profiling on the foreshore of Colwyn Bay, North Wales, as per the 2021/22 works. As part of the application process we require your comment.

The beach management works are the same as the previously approved Marine Licence: CML2107, see attached.

As per the previous works please find attached a location plan showing the extent of the sand re-profiling. The works entail the use of a bulldozer, excavator and dumper to re-profile the beach to its original design profile.
