Hi Daniel

Thank you for the notice of the sand re-profiling works.

Provided the works are wholly within the sand layer and do not penetrate the marine clays and peat layers below, where prehistoric remains may be present, there should be no issues with the proposed works.

It is worth noting that some former ship wreck locations are recorded on the RCAHMW National Monuments record close to the northern boundary of the works area. Their precise location and the sub-surface level at which they may be preserved is not known and there is a chance they could be within the works area. I noted you have the wrong contact email for the Royal Commission who maintain a list of wrecks and can advise on any precautions necessary - the correct contact is Dr Julian Whitewright (Marine Investigator RCAHMW) via julian.whitewright@rcahmw.gov.uk

Dear Sir,

We are in the process of submitting a Band 1 Marine Licence Application for sand re-profiling on the foreshore of Colwyn Bay, North Wales, as per the 2021/22 works. As part of the application process we require your comment.

The beach management works are the same as the previously approved Marine Licence: CML2107, see attached.

As per the previous works please find attached a location plan showing the extent of the sand re-profiling. The works entail the use of a bulldozer, excavator and dumper to re-profile the beach to its original design profile.

Our Coastal Contractor will provide Method Statements and Risk Assessments for the works, which will include suitable fencing / signage as required for safe execution of the task.

As per the 2021/22 works we will only be working in the sand layer and redistributing the existing sand to the design profile as it was placed in 2014/15.
