- **Brief site and licensing history and previous land use**

Applicants currently hold a WML for site opposite this plot. Due to increased amounts of inert waste received, the company wish to expand and have a separate inert transfer station. They wish to produce aggregates from inert and excavation wastes using WRAP protocol

- **Brief description of the activities to be permitted. Including any exempt activities and discharge consents:**

This permit will be a fixed licence for the keeping and treatment of inert and excavation wastes, to include crushing , sorting and segregation and storage. Maximum annual throughput up to 24999 tonnes.

Receipt of submission

Calculation of fee paid and correct Charging Table:

A sum of £3758, which is the standard fee for this application under Table 2 Part E (b) was received on 13th March 2007. The application was Duly Made on 29th March 2007 as the application was incomplete and further documents were received on this date.

- The site is not within 1km of a SPA, SAC or SSSI so further consultation was not required.

2. Fit and Proper Status**Assessment of Relevant Convictions**

Key Points for Consideration of Completed Decision Document

Application for a new licence

The decision document for a new licence should demonstrate that the following requirements of the Act have been met:

- the licence holder will be a Fit and Proper Person, and
- will be in occupation of the licensed area (in the case of a site licence), or
- will be the operator of the plant (in the case of a mobile plant licence), and
- that the proposed use of the land has the benefit of an appropriate planning permission (where required), and
- that the activities, if conducted in accordance with licence conditions, will not cause pollution of the environment or harm to human health or, in cases where this is not covered by planning permission, serious detriment to the amenities of the locality.

Modification of licence conditions

- A notice of modification under Section 37(1)(b) of the Act can only modify conditions to the extent requested by the applicant. Where other conditions are to be modified or new conditions inserted as a result of the modification, each condition must be justified as being 37(1)(a) or 37(2)(a), and separate notices should be prepared where more than one section is being used.
- Planning permission is not a prerequisite to the issue of a modification notice, however the planning authority's views may be a key element in the determination of whether the modification may cause pollution of the environment, harm to human health or, where relevant, serious detriment to the amenities of the locality.
- Financial provision and technical competence should be in place to address any new obligations expected from the modification application.

Transfer of licence

- The grounds for determination of an application to transfer a licence are solely those that relate to the fit and proper person status of the proposed transferee.

Surrender of licence

- The decision document should indicate whether the condition of the land, in so far as that condition is the result of the use of that land for the treatment, keeping or disposal of waste (whether or not in pursuance of the licence), is likely or unlikely to cause pollution of the environment or harm to human health.

Financial Provision

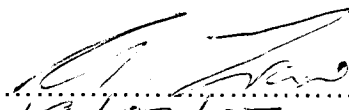
