Dear Mr Parker

Thank you for your time our visit, as discussed there were a few remaining issues picked up during the visit which will need to be finalised.

The site needs an identification notice which should be mounted on the outside of the business (main gate / billboard / fencing) that will be easily readable and including details of emergency contact name and telephone number of the permit operator and/or holder, statement that the site is permitted by the Environment Agency, permit number and the Environment Agency national Numbers, 08708 506506 and 0800 807060. (Permit condition 1.1)

Analysis needs to be undertaken on the manure/wash water that is being spread to land, and a nutrient management plan for the area should be in place. Under the plan you should keep records of the date and quantity of material that you spread, the nutrient requirements of the land based on grass or crop need and current nutrient levels of the soil (soil analysis should be undertaken every 4 years) (Permit condition 2.3.1)

Bunding needs to take place around your oil tank storage area before the tank is used again. The bund must meet the requirements of The Control of Pollution (Silage Slurry and Agricultural Fuel Oil) Regulations 1991. The current valves will also need to be within the bunded area.

The above breaches have incurred the following scores and will be subject to a warning letter for failing to comply with your permit.

Failure to undertake soil analysis (permit condition 2.3.1) – CCS 3
Failure to observe organic loadings (permit condition 2.3.1) – CCS 3
Missing information on site ID board (permit condition 1.1) – CCS 4
Inadequate bunding for oil tank (permit condition 3.3) – CCS 3
