Warning Letter

Dear Sir/Madam

Failure to comply with a Regulation 36 Notice signed on Fenestration Recycling Company Limited on 7 October 2016. The Notice required "The waste shall be stored on site in accordance with Storage Plan, Drg No. 10937-000-E and Site (BLOCK) Plan, Drg No. 10937-000-C that form part of the Fire Prevention and Mitigation Plan (MPP5)."

We believe that you have committed the following offence:

Offence: Regulation 38(3) of The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016

Date: 2 May 2017

We have issued this **warning letter** as a response to the above offence(s) on this occasion. However, our decision could change if any further relevant information comes to light, including, but not restricted to, information that:

- Fenestration Recycling Company Limited have committed earlier offences;
- the environmental impacts of this offence is greater than we presently understand them;
- the offences are continuing or have been repeated;
- Fenestration Recycling Company Limited have committed other offences of which we are presently unaware.

We will take this offence into account if we consider that Fenestration Recycling Company

Limited is involved in any future offending.

This warning does not:

- prevent any other prosecuting authority taking action against you/the Company; or
- affect our right to issue enforcement, clear-up or remediation notices, or seek recovery of costs or damages according to law.
