Environment Management System Summary

Pic Up Spares has always been fully committed to improving how we operate our business and the impact our business has on the environment. We are continually reviewing how we improve our carbon foot print and environmental impacts.

Our Environment system is in place to review the company from top to bottom, from office staff to the dismantling of our vehicles. For our office staff we review how we can reduce paper and electrical power wastage on a regular basis. This year we have introduced an android based system for our recovery drivers, which in turn has dramatically reduced the need for paper and all our offices have been fitted with led lights and storage buildings fitted with LED movement sensor lighting. Next year we are looking to introduce emailed receipts for customers as opposed to paper receipts which will dramatically reduce our paper usage.

Our all vehicles and equipment are regularly checked for defects that could pollute the environment and this year we purchased a new recovery lorry that is more fuel efficient and lower emissions. We have also purchased a catalytic converter decanner which allows use to ship out the precious metals in containers in one go, thus reducing the carbon foot print on delivery of the metals. We have also recently purchased a new handler machine which allows for more recovery of metals and materials from end of life vehicles, so allowing more recyclable material to be extracted from vehicles.

Pic Up Spares is continually looking at ways we can improve how we remove clean, package and store our products in a manner that can benefit our business and also have a positive impact on the environment.

Our environment management system is in place to minimise environmental impacts concerning our activities, products and services. We do this by:

- Prevent pollution, reduce waste and minimise the consumption of resources.
