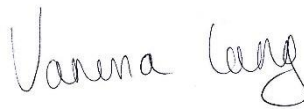

If Natural Resources Wales do not receive the full payment by **26 March 2018** then, under section 41(6) of the Environment Act 1995, Natural Resources Wales may revoke or suspend your permit to the extent that it authorises the carrying on of an authorised activity.

If Natural Resources Wales revoke or suspend your permit for non-payment you will not be authorised to carry out the permitted activities. The charges outstanding must still be paid and we may take court action to recover them. In addition, future charges may continue to accrue under the permit, for which you would be liable.
