Current operational status of Fox lane landfill, Blaencilgoed Farm

Further to your recent request for a statement on the operational status of the inert landfill at Fox lane I carried out an inspection on 7th May 2015. I can confirm that the site is now restored and is no longer in the operational phase i.e. it is now closed and not receiving waste. I noted that the site is now grassed over and appears to have been returned to agricultural use.

As you are aware you previously informed me that you have decided not to apply to surrender the permit for the site. At this time there is no regulatory requirement for you to do this but I must advise you that any amendments to the Environmental Permitting Regulations and/or changes to NRW's operational guidance may require you to surrender the permit in the future.

During my visit I also noted the stockpile of aggregates adjacent to your silage store; having spoken to your son I understand that this is required for base material for new sheds and was taken from the former storage area above the landfill. I inspected this area and am satisfied that it has now been cleared. I confirm that the storage of the aggregates pending use is separate to the landfill operation and status.

Our records show that you hold a U1 exemption (use of waste in construction) for agricultural waste; however, to use the aggregate in your shed project you will need to register a U1 exemption for non-agricultural waste. This is because the material was originally imported to the site during the operational phase of the landfill. This exemption can be registered on-line at our website.

Re: Restoration works at Fox Lane Landfill Site

I refer to the recent site visit with the Minerals & Waste Monitoring Officer Mr Jonathan Lewis regarding the restoration works at the Fox Lane Landfill Site Blaencilgoed Farm Ludchurch.

I would confirm on inspection of the restoration works that the Local Planning Authority is very pleased with the quality of the restoration work with the ground levels, the soil profiles and the reseeded and overall package that has allowed the site to be restored for agricultural use.

There are naturally small areas adjacent to the track that will need additional work when the weather improves to allow better drainage and these matters are in hand as discussed at our previous meeting.

I would therefore confirm that the site is classified as restored and would be regarded as in a period of aftercare. There would be a yearly inspection at a rate of £96 for a 5 year timescale.

There are two other areas at Blaencilgoed Farm which would require your attention again discussed at the previous site visit which includes the small area adjacent to the restoration site which involves re-grading and levelling of soils and tar macadam scalplings.

The other area is the appeal site at the top of the lane which the Planning Inspector required the site to be cleared of the crushed stone, the hard-standing to be removed and reinstated to an agricultural field.

I would be obliged if you could contact Mr Lewis on 01558 825 313, 07789371158 or by email JMLewis@carmarthenshire.gov.uk within the next 7 days to discuss the timescale of the works as the material can be used for several purposes on your land including the road base for the wind turbine permission and the infill purposes for the agricultural sheds and on cow tracks around the farm.


I refer to the reinstatement works at the planning appeal site at Blaencilgoed Farm nr Ludchurch.

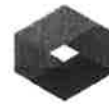
