Warning letter

Dear Sir / Madam

M&R Commercials GP3193MV

We believe that you have committed the following offences:

Offence: Regulation 38(2) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016

Date: On 6 April 2017 T M Wiberg failed to comply with the permit condition 2.3.1. Table 2.3 because they stored lead acid batteries outside without a lid to prevent the ingress of water, and condition 3.1.3 because liquids were stored in containers and they did not provide secondary containment.

Offence: Regulation 38(2) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016

Date: On 7 November 2017 T M Wiberg failed to comply with permit condition 1.1.2 because they failed to update their management system that identifies and minimises the risk of pollution.

We have issued this **warning letter** as a response to the above offences on this occasion. However, our decision could change if any further relevant information comes to light, including, but not restricted to, information that:

- the Company has committed earlier offences;
- the environmental impacts of these offences are greater than we presently understand them;

- the offences are continuing or have been repeated;
- the Company has committed other offences of which we are presently unaware.

We will take these offences into account if we consider that the Company is involved in any future offending.

This warning does not:

- prevent any other prosecuting authority taking action against you/the Company; or
- affect our right to issue enforcement, clear-up or remediation notices, or seek recovery of costs or damages according to law.
