Thank you for your application of 15 July 2016. Unfortunately the change you have requested cannot be carried out under an administrative variation. This means it's not duly made and we must return it to you. The removal of an area of land from your permit would be considered a partial-surrender of your permit as we would have to assess if area being surrendered has been returned to its original state and no pollution to land or groundwater had taken place.

You would have to complete and supply application forms Part A, D2 and F1, a site plan of the remaining area, a completed site condition report for the area of land you wish to surrender and a fee of either £2532 if applying for a low risk surrender, or £3588 if you are applying for a normal (i.e. non low-risk) surrender
