Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit. This variation increases the site boundary, increases the waste throughput from less than 25,000 tonnes a year to less than 75,000 tonnes a year, adds an inert waste facility and updates some conditions. This variation incorporates the inert recycling facility which adjoins the site operating under a paragraph 13 exemption.

1.2 Permitted wastes

1.2.1 Permitted categories and types of wastes

No wastes other than those which are specified in section 1.5 and Appendix I of the working plan shall be accepted at the site.

1.2.2 Permitted quantities of wastes

The total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 75,000 tonnes.

4.3 Fires on site

4.3.2 Fire Action Plan

In the event of a fire on the site (except those which are specified waste management operations under these conditions), fire action plan shall be implemented immediately and actions taken recorded, in accordance with section 4.8 of the working plan.

4.4.1 Waste Acceptance Procedures

All wastes shall be received, inspected, accepted or rejected and recorded as detailed in sections 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 5.1.2 and 5.1.4 of the Working Plan.

4.6 Waste quantity measurement systems

Means of measurement

4.6.1 All wastes accepted and wastes despatched from the site shall be measured and calculated as detailed in sections 2.5 of the Working Plan.

4.8 Specified Waste Treatment Process

Process, plant and equipment and procedures

4.8.1 Any waste treatment processes as permitted under condition 1.1.1 shall only be carried out in accordance with sections 2.9 and 4.4 of the Working Plan.

6.1 Control, monitoring and reporting of dusts, fibres and particulates

Measures shall be implemented and maintained throughout the operational life of the site to control and monitor emissions of dusts, fibres, and particulates from the site, in accordance with this condition, and section 4.4 of the Working Plan.

6.3 Control of noise

6.3.1 Measures shall be implemented and maintained throughout the operational life of the site, in accordance with this condition, and section 4.9 of the working plan, to control and minimise the levels of noise from operations on the site beyond the site boundary.

3 Site Infrastructure

3.1 Provision of site identification board

3.1.3 The board shall be easily readable from outside the site entrance in daylight hours, and shall display the following information:

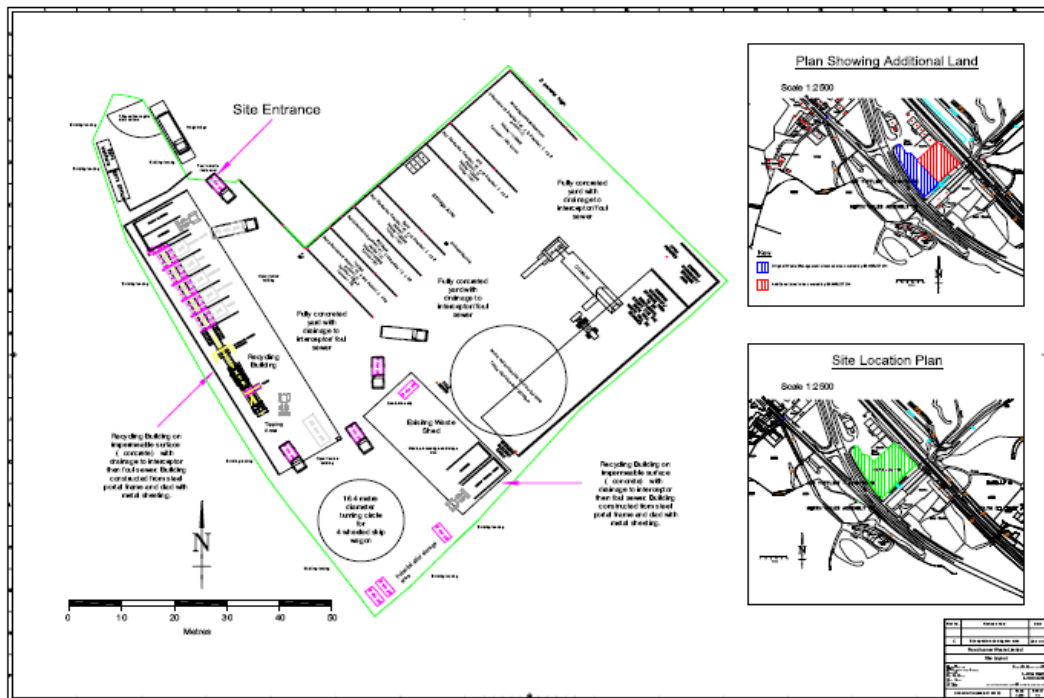
- a) Permit Holder name (company name, not individual name unless justified as necessary)
- b) Operator name (company name, not individual name unless justified as necessary)
- c) Permit number;
- d) Emergency contact name and telephone number (for security reasons, personal names and home phone numbers should not be used except where no alternative is practicable)
- e) Statement that the site is permitted by the Environment Agency
- f) Agency national numbers: 0800 807060
- g) The location of the noticeboard should be such that it is clear that it does not designate areas outside the permitted site and does not encourage illegal tipping.
