Schedule

1. Technical Competence

In the application you have indicated that you are using the joint CIWM/WAMITAB scheme to provide evidence of technical competence for the activity. Following a request for information as part of the duly making stage of this application, you provided a Continuing Competence certificate but no evidence of an 'original' award (e.g. Certificate of Technical Competence / Operator Competence Certificate).

Action: Please provide evidence that the nominated Technical Competent Manager (TCM) holds a relevant 'original' award for the activity. Details of suitable awards (current and hierarchy are available at <http://www.wamitab.org.uk/pg/risk-tier-table-april-2016>.

If the nominated TCM does not currently hold a relevant award, they may use the 'grace period' in the CIWM/WAMITAB scheme (information available here:

http://www.wamitab.org.uk/useruploads/files/competence/scheme_document_update_v6_jan_2014.pdf). To do this you need to provide evidence to us that they have registered for a relevant award, and confirm to us that they intend to use the 'grace period'.

2. Storage/Treatment activities; Recovery and Disposal Codes

Section 1.1 of the Environment Management System ('EMS Baglan') provided in the application suggests that storage of waste is the only proposed activity at the site. However, in your email response on 30/06/2016 to a request for information as part of the duly making stage of this application, you provided the recovery and disposal codes R03.04.02, R01, R03.01.03 and R13, which suggests that you intend to carry out treatment as well as storage activities at the site.

The inclusion of recovery code R01 (use principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy) in your email of 30/06/2016 suggests that you are intending to burn/combust waste at the site. However the Environment Management System suggests that no waste will be burnt at the site.

Action: Please confirm:

- a) whether or not you intend to carry out any treatment activities at the site (note: bulking up for onward transfer is considered to be a treatment activity);
- b) the recovery and disposal codes for the activities that you propose to carry out at the site;
- c) whether or not you intend to burn/combust waste at the site.

3. Dust and Particulate Matter

The proposed activities / wastes to be accepted at the site have the potential to generate / contain dusts and particulate matter (e.g. wood dust / chipped wood etc). Therefore this risk needs to be addressed in the application, including appropriate prevention and mitigation measures. The Environment Management System ('EMS Baglan') provided in the application suggests that control of dusts is addressed in Appendix 3.1 to the document, but this appendix does not appear to have been provided (neither do any of the other appendices listed in the contents page).

Action: Please provide information on how you will prevent / mitigate the risk of dusts and particulate matter at the site and prevent their emission from the site. This information can form part of your Environment Management System or be contained in a separate document.
