A1 – Household, commercial and industrial waste transfer station with treatment	<p>D15 Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)</p> <p>R13 Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)</p> <p>D14 Repackaging prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D13</p> <p>D9 Physico-chemical treatment not specified elsewhere in this Annex which results in final compounds or mixtures which are discarded by means of any of the operations numbered D1 to D12 (e.g. evaporation, drying, calcination, etc.)</p> <p>R3 Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes)</p> <p>R4 Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds</p> <p>R5 Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials</p>	<p>All waste must be treated within a building, on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage to foul sewer.</p> <p>All waste must be stored on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage to foul sewer.</p> <p>Biodegradable kitchen and canteen waste (EWC 20 01 08) must be stored within a building. All other waste can be stored within a building, or outside.</p> <p>Waste cannot be stored externally (D15 or R13 activities) between 1st April to 31st October for each calendar year.</p> <p>Treatment operations shall be limited to manual and/or mechanical:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– shredding– screening– metal removal (magnets and/or eddy current)– compaction– bailing– wrapping <p>of permitted wastes for the purpose of disposal or recovery.</p> <p>The treatment of wastes for the purpose of disposal at the site shall be limited to 50 tonnes per day in total, for the pre-treatment of waste for incineration or co-incineration.</p> <p>The treatment of wastes for the purpose of recovery or a mix of recovery and disposal at the site shall be limited to 75 tonnes per day in total, for the pre-treatment of waste for incineration or co-incineration.</p> <p>Waste types as specified in Table S2.1</p>
