Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 59(1)(a) notice –

Removal of wood waste from land at the rear of Locks Yard, Heol Llan, Coity, Bridgend, CF35 6BU.

Please find enclosed a legal notice (with accompanying photographs and plan) pursuant to a Section 59 (1)(a) Environmental Protection Act 1990. The notice requires you to move all waste wood chip which is now being stored on land at the rear of Locks Yard, Heol Llan, Coity, Bridgend, CF35 6BU, by **Friday 26th October 2018**.

Storage and blending of waste wood chip on land at the rear of Locks Yard, Heol Llan, Coity:

It is understood that the removal of this material will involve the treatment (through blending with inert materials) of waste. Natural Resources Wales will allow this process under the following conditions;

- You will not cause nuisance through odour or noise
- You will not cause nuisance or pollution through dust. Effective dust mitigation and clean up measures must be employed during the activity.
- You will not cause further pollution or harm to the environment.
- No other treatment of waste other than the blending of fire damaged wood waste and inert materials must take place
- Only the minimum required amount of inert waste is brought on site for the treatment (blending) process

- Operations cease immediately if there is any sign of potential pollution
- Records (copies transfer notes) of all outgoing waste movements are provided to Natural Resources Wales' South West Waste Regulation Team

Statutory Notice

**Environmental Protection Act 1990

NOTICE TO REMOVE CONTROLLED WASTE

Under Section 59(1)(a) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, **Natural Resources Wales** can require the removal of controlled waste.

Being satisfied that the controlled waste, namely, waste wood chip, as pictured in photographs **DM01, DM02, DM03, DM04 and DM05** has been deposited in contravention of Regulation 12 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010.

Natural Resources Wales requires you to remove the above mentioned waste which is now being stored on land at the rear of Locks Yard, Heol Llan, Coity, Bridgend, CF35 6BU (as shown edged in red on the attached plan **Map-1**) in response to a fire at Locks Yard, Heol Llan, Coity, Bridgend, CF35 6BU, by **Friday 26th October 2018**.

3. Failure to comply with this notice is an offence under Section 59(5) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and may result in legal action being taken against you.

Appeal provisions

You are entitled to appeal against this Notice under Sections 59ZA(5) and 59(2) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990. Notice of appeal must be made within a period of 21 days beginning with the service of this notice to a Magistrate's Court by way of a complaint. The requirements of this notice shall have no effect pending the determination of the appeal.

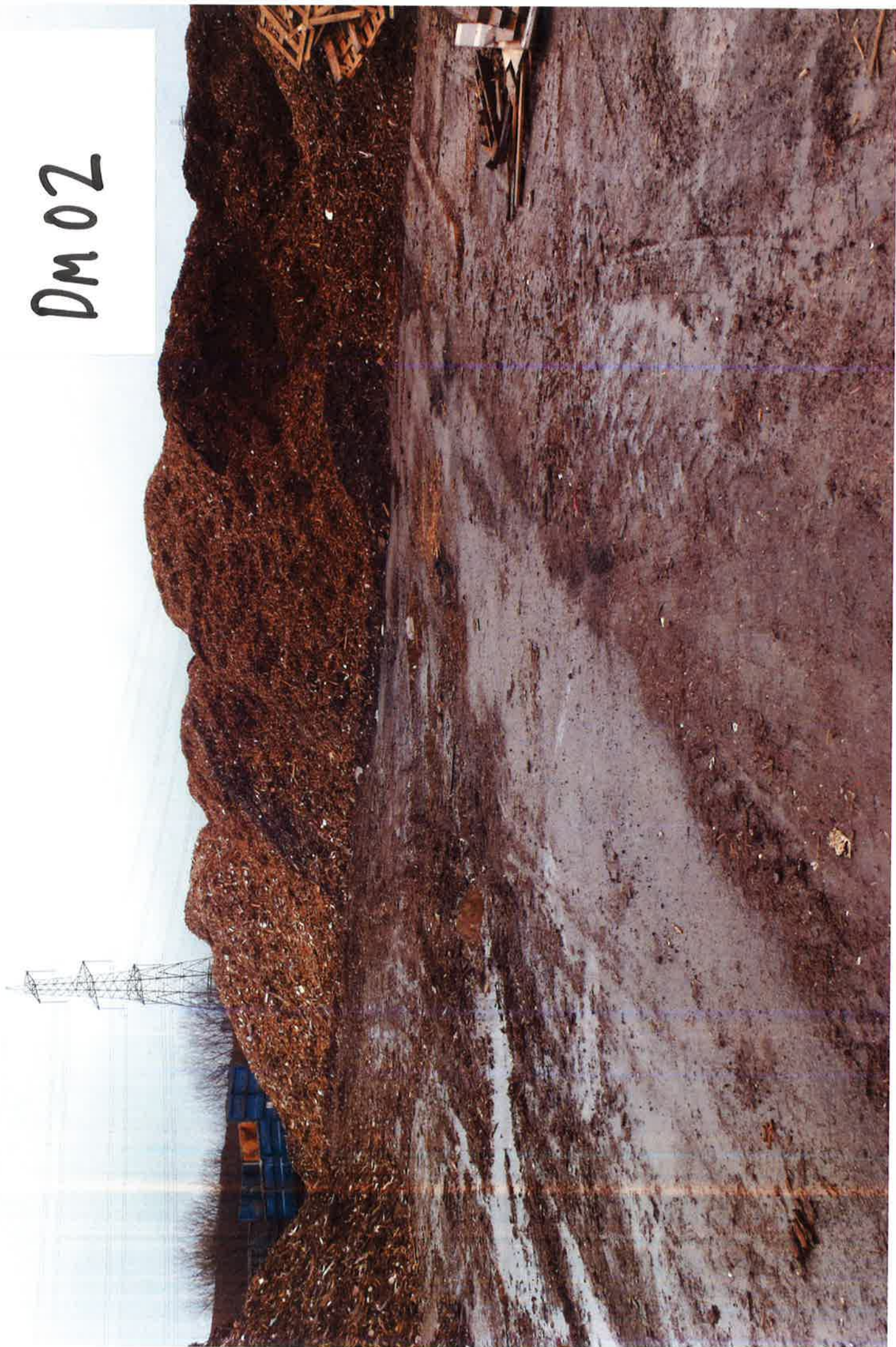
Legislation note

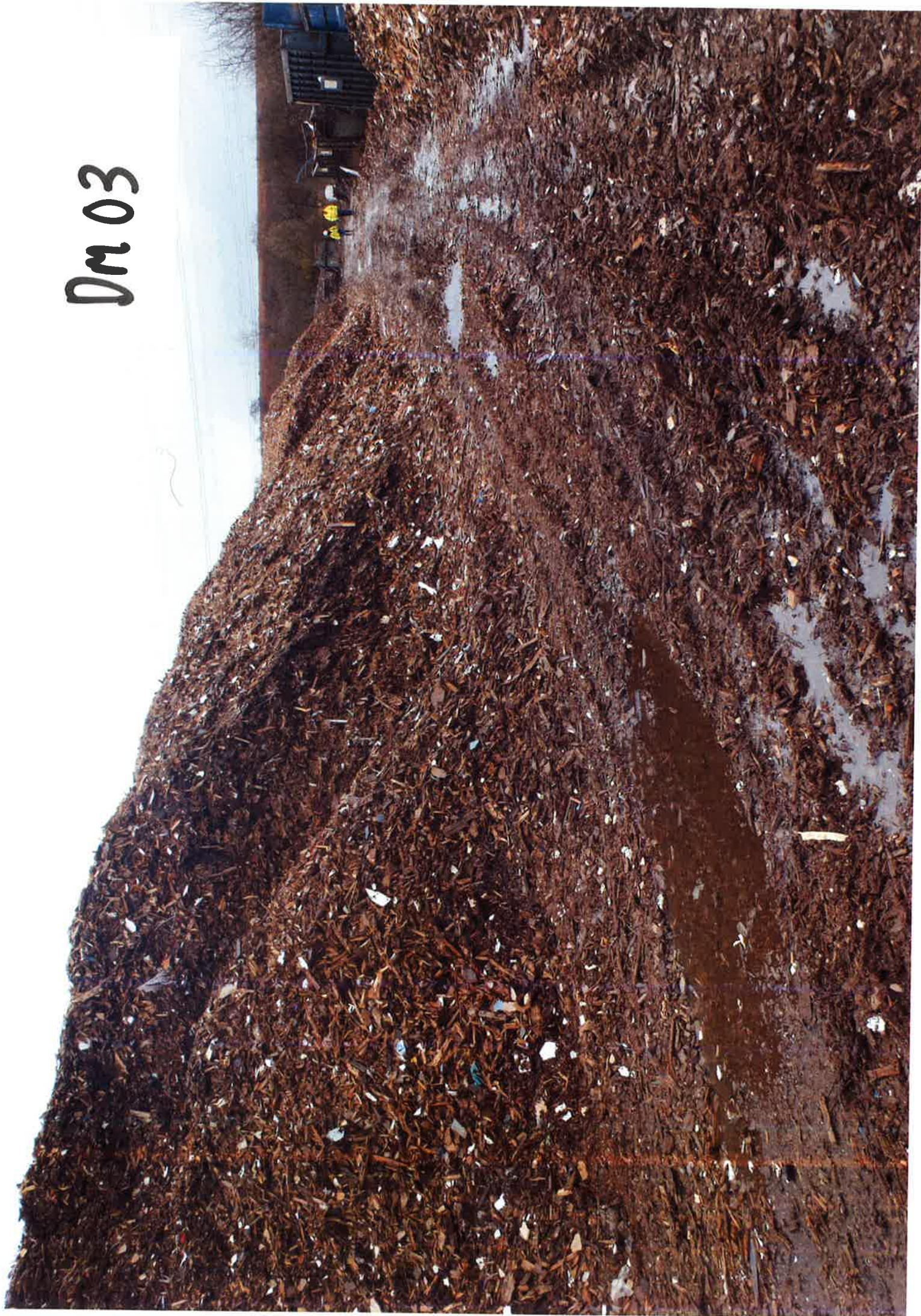

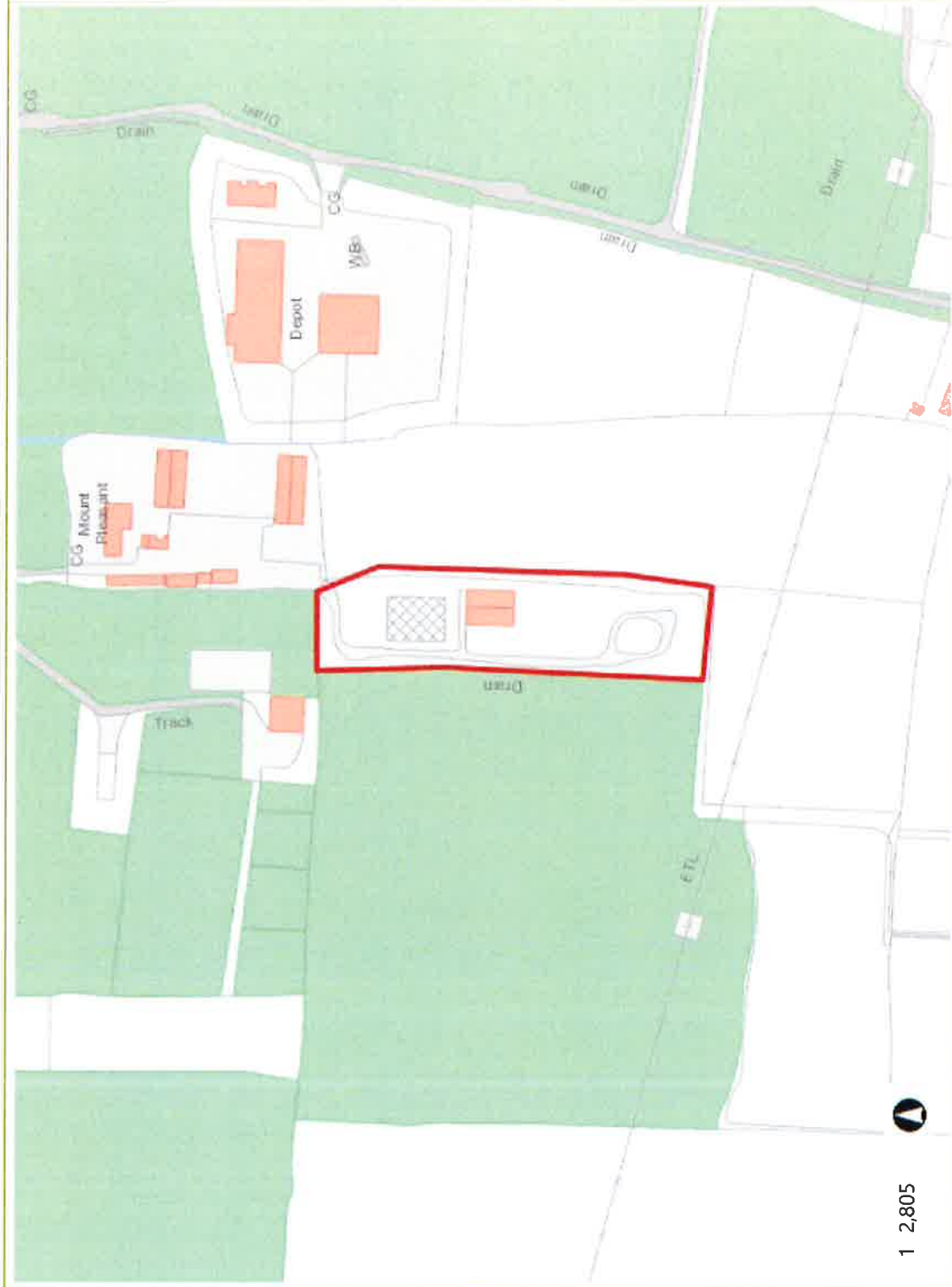
