MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009: PART 4 – MARINE LICENSING

LICENCE FOR REMOVAL OF THE GWYNT Y MOR WIND FARM MET MAST

I am pleased to advise you that the Marine Licensing Team within Natural Resources Wales, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, as Licensing Authority, has considered **RWE Renewables UK Ltd** email dated 04 March 2022 requesting amendments to licence conditions 3.19.1 to a Marine Licence under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, and hereby grant the Marine Licence for you to undertake the above stated works.

Accordingly, please find attached for your review and retention a copy of Marine Licence **RML2109v1** and its conditions. Please note that Marine Licence **RML2109v1** supersedes Marine Licence **RML2109** in its entirety.

Changes to conditions 3.19.1 and 3.20.2, and the addition of conditions 3.19.5, 3.19.6 and 3.19.7.

Advisory Note

The Licence Holder should copy navigation@trinityhouse.co.uk into appropriate Notices to Mariners as required under licence condition 3.1.3.

If in the opinion of the Secretary of State the assistance of a Government Department, including the broadcast of navigational warnings, is required in connection with the works or to deal with any emergency arising from the failure to mark and light the works as required by the consent or to maintain the works in good order or from the drifting or wreck of the works, the owner of the works may be liable for any expense incurred in securing such assistance.

The Licence Holder must ensure that any jack up vessel when jacked up exhibits aids to navigation, in accordance with the UK Standard Marking Schedule for Offshore Installations.

The Licence Holder must ensure that any vessel engaged in the works exhibits the appropriate navigation signals in accordance with the Convention on the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972 (COLREGs).

It is advised that the Licence Holder engages with NRW TE by contacting Marine Area Advice and Management Team marine.area.advice@cyfoethnaturiolcymru.gov.uk prior to the

commencement of the seabed surveys and other licence conditions that require approval from the Licensing Authority.

Marine Licence, **RML2109v1**, constitutes a statutory consent; therefore, the conditions set out herein must be complied with in full and will be binding upon any agent or contractor who undertakes any activity on the project on your behalf.

Marine Licence, **RML2109v1** is solely granted for the work to be undertaken with the area specified in the Licence; however, it does not absolve you from applying for further consents or licences as necessary to enable the full completion of your project.

If the works authorised by this Licence are unlikely to be completed by the expiry date, the Licence Holder should apply for a replacement marine licence **at least 4 months** prior to the expiry date of this Licence.

Should you require clarification as to the reasons for the inclusion of any of the conditions attached to the Licence then you must request written notice within 28 days of the receipt of this letter.

Finally, once again, please ensure you have read and understood Marine Licence **RML2109v1**. Should you have any queries with regards to your Marine Licence then please do not hesitate to contact the Marine Licensing Team.
