Technical ability (EPR Part D2 - 4b)

1. You have indicated that you are using WAMITAB to show you have the suitable technical skills and knowledge to manage the facility. However, the certificate provided is not appropriate for the type of operation permitted. The certificate is held for 'Inert Landfills (Open) (4MLIO6)', the appropriate certificate for the operation based on standard rule set SR2010 No12 would be 'Level 4 Low Risk Operator Competence for Non-Hazardous Treatment to Produce Soil (601/8513/2) (LROC2)'. LROC2 includes two units that are not covered by 4MLIO6; Manage site operations for the treatment of non-hazardous waste, and Manage the transfer of outputs and disposal of residues from waste treatment and recovery operations, non-hazardous waste.

Action: Provide appropriate evidence to show you have suitable technical skills and knowledge to manage the facility. This could be achieved by providing evidence to show that the above units have been completed by the holder of the certificate, or choosing an alternative technically competent person with the appropriate Certificate of Technical Competence (COTC) – this could be a hired in consultant provided that they are in a position to direct activities on the site. Further information on technical competence can be found in Regulatory Guidance Note No. 5 (RGN 5) Operator Competence, including alternative methods of showing technical ability.
