Subject: ICT Deeside Paper Mill - Pre application information request for Natural Resources Wales

All,

Please find attached the minutes of the pre-application meeting with Natural Resources Wales (NRW) for the Deeside Paper Mill. Following on from this initial meeting, we are now looking to request further technical information that you may require from NRW to help inform your technical assessments etc. which will be used to inform the environmental permit application.

From discussions and email with various parties and the feedback from NRW following the meeting, it appears that the discharge to the River Dee is the most pressing item that will have the most impact on the design of the plant etc. NRW informed us during the meeting that some of the other permitted sites in the vicinity and having discharges into the River Dee have restrictions imposed that only allow batch discharges on an outgoing tide and seasonal temperature variation restrictions. I have attached some copies of these permits to show examples of the emissions limits etc. You will see that the permit for Kimberley-Clark Flint Paper Mill has a batch discharge and the Connah's Quay Power Station has a seasonal temperature variation. Whilst these not be the case for the Deeside Paper Mill, it is something that needs to be considered as part of the technical assessments.

In addition to the assessment of the impacts from the emissions to water, the environmental permit application will include assessments of the impacts from emissions to air, fugitive emissions (such as dust, noise and odour), management systems in place to minimise risk to the environment e.g. drainage shut-off valves, automatic

shutdown procedures, monitoring systems, hazardous materials storage etc. and the condition of the site at the time of the permit application. This information will largely come from some of the assessments that you are preparing.

Lastly, I have attached some copies of environmental permits as examples of those issued for other paper mills within Wales. You may find these useful to give an idea of the regulatory requirements etc. that will be placed on ICT by the environmental permit.

I am in the office on Monday and Tuesday next week if you wish to discuss the requirements etc. for the environmental permit application and how your assessments feed into this.

Please can you send me your information requests for NRW by **Wednesday 16th October 2019** so that I can prepare the information to send to NRW by the end of next week.
