Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

Schedule 1 of the Environmental Permitting Regulations was updated by the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 to reflect the implementation of the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) into England and Wales. Following this, Natural Resources Wales has varied Table 2.1 of the permit to include limits which the operator must operate below to remain a waste facility, resulting from the introduction of the Industrial Emissions Directive.

The site technically has the capacity to operate above the threshold limits detailed within the IED, specifically S5.6A(1)(a), Temporary storage of hazardous waste with a total capacity exceeding 50 tonnes, however, they have chosen to put physical measures in place to operate below the threshold to remain permitted as a waste facility. Therefore, Natural Resources Wales has included these physical limits within the permit to incorporate them as an enforceable permit condition.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

Table 2.1 Specified waste management operations

Description of specified activity and WFD Annex I and II operations	Limits of Specified Activity and Waste Types
D9: Physico-chemical treatment not specified elsewhere in this Annex which results in final compounds or mixtures which are discarded by means of any of the operations numbered D1 to D12 (e.g. evaporation, drying, calcination, etc.)	Treatment consisting of manual sorting, separation, shredding, screening, baling, compacting, crushing of non-hazardous or inert waste into different components for recovery or disposal (no more than 50 tonnes per day). Non-hazardous waste must be treated on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.
R3: Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents, including composting and other biological transformation processes	Inert wastes must be treated on hard standing or an impermeable surface with sealed drainage. There <u>must not</u> be any treatment of WEEE.
R4: Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds	Wastes which arrive in bags or other non-rigid containers shall be transferred into rigid containers immediately.
R5: Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic compounds	Rigid containers for the storage of wastes shall be of a design that: • Will prevent the escape of any liquid • Has a lockable lid or other means of securing the container. Body parts and organs shall be stored in designated lockable units. The transfer of wastes from vehicles or containers shall only take place on areas with an impermeable surface with sealed drainage. Washing and disinfection of mobile containers must take place on areas of impermeable surface with sealed drainage.

Table 2.1 Specified waste management operations

Description of specified activity and WFD Annex I and II operations	Limits of Specified Activity and Waste Types
D15: Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced)	Hazardous and non-hazardous waste must be kept on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage. Inert wastes must be kept on hard standing or on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.
R13: Storage of wastes pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced)	Temporary storage of hazardous waste, pending any of the activities listed in Sections 5.1, 5.2 and 5.3 of the environmental permitting regulations shall not exceed a total capacity of 50 tonnes. This includes any underground storage of hazardous waste but does not include temporary storage pending collection of waste generated on site.
D14: Repackaging prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D13
