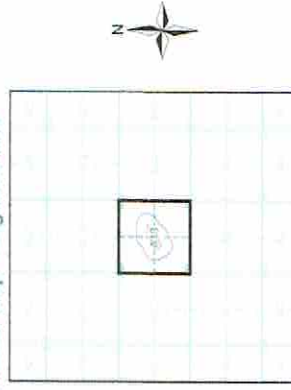

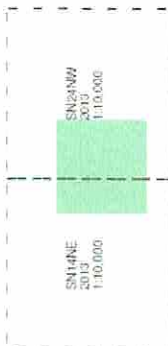

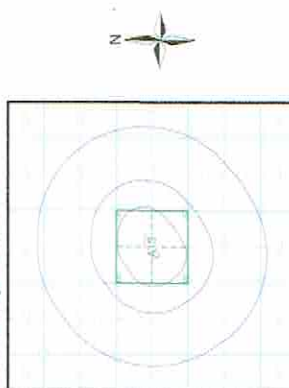

Boundary information depiction includes county, unitary authority, district, civil parish and constituency.

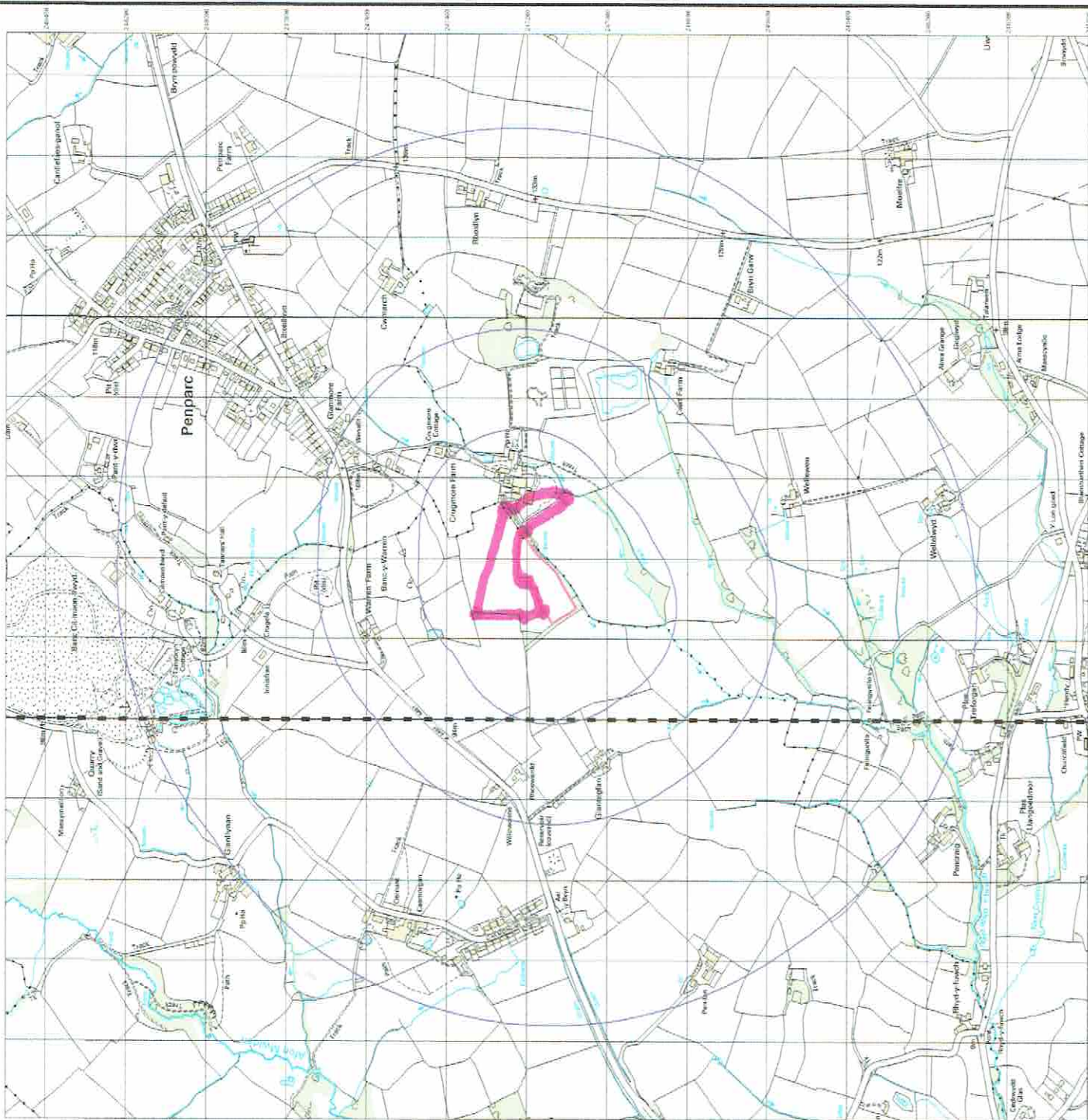

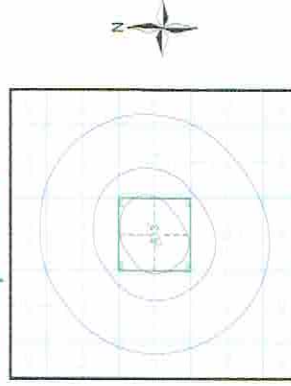

Road names are also included together with the relevant road number and classification. Boundary information depiction includes county, unitary authority, district, civil parish and constituency.

'Large Scale National Grid Data' superseded SIM cards (Ordnance Survey's 'Survey of Information on Microfilm') in 1992, and continued to be produced until 1995. These maps were the fore-runners of digital mapping and so contained information on topography, buildings, roads, but tend to show less topographic detail than maps at smaller scales. These maps were produced at both 1:2,500 and 1:1,250 scales.

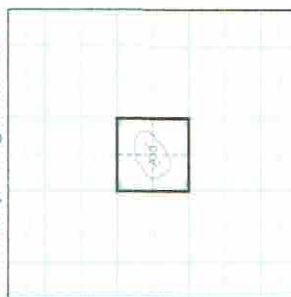
