**NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PERMIT**

Under Regulation 22 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010, we may revoke an environmental permit.

Natural Resources Wales has decided to revoke the environmental permit for this regulated facility **with effect from** 11 November 2013.

The reason for this decision:

The Waste Framework Directive 2008/98/EC provides that certain wastes are excluded from the scope of the Directive, these include by virtue of Article 2 (2) (c) carcasses of animals that have died other than by being slaughtered, including animals killed to eradicate epizootic diseases, and that are disposed of in accordance with Regulation EC No 1774/2002 (now regulation EC No 1069/2009).

We are satisfied that the activity permitted by this permit allows pet carcasses and incidental wrapping only and that the incinerator/pet cemetery has been approved by an authorisation, number 52/146/8007 INC issued by Animal Health.

As from 11 November 2013, Natural Resources Wales will no longer regulate your waste facility.

## **Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 Regulation 22**

### **Notes:**

#### **General**

1. This notice revokes the activities, which were previously permitted by your environmental permit.
2. You have a right of appeal against this notice. Unless you have appealed against this notice, carrying on the activities which are no longer permitted as a result of this notice is an offence and legal action may be taken against you.
3. You may wish to seek independent legal advice.

#### **Appeal provisions**

You are entitled to appeal against this notice under Regulation 31(2)(f) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010. Notice of appeal must be given before the date on which this notice takes effect. Where an appeal is brought the revocation will not take effect until the final determination or withdrawal of the appeal.

You must send written notice of the appeal and the documents listed below to:

At the same time, you must send a copy of the appeal notice and documents to us.

The required documents are:

a statement of the grounds of appeal;  
a copy of any relevant application;  
a copy of any relevant environmental permit;  
a copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator;  
a copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal; and  
a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.

You may withdraw an appeal by notifying the Welsh Ministers in writing and sending a copy of that notification to us.
