Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

The notice gives effect to two changes.

The first is an operator initiated administrative variation of a tier 3 bespoke permit to add:

- One new treatment activity (bulking up) to Table S1.1.
- One new waste code (EWC 20 03 01- mixed municipal waste) to Table S2.1

The second change is a regulator initiated variation to add conditions 3.3.2 (relating to noise and vibration management) and 3.4.2 (relating to pest management) to the permit which were excluded in error from the original permit issued 24/07/13.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

Schedule 3 – conditions to be added

The following conditions are added following a Natural Resources Wales initiated variation:

3.3.2 The operator shall:

- (a) if notified by Natural Resources Wales that the activities are giving rise to pollution outside the site due to noise and vibration, submit to Natural Resources Wales for approval within the period specified, a noise and vibration management plan which identifies and minimises the risks of pollution from noise and vibration;
- (b) implement the approved noise and vibration management plan, from the date of approval, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Natural Resources Wales.

3.4.2 The operator shall:

- (a) if notified by Natural Resources Wales, submit to Natural Resources Wales for approval within the period specified, a pests management plan which identifies and minimises risks of pollution, hazard or annoyance from pests;
- (b) implement the pests management plan, from the date of approval, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Natural resources Wales.
