Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

Schedule 1 of the Environmental Permitting Regulations was updated by the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 to reflect the implementation of the Industrial Emissions Directive (IED) into England and Wales. Following this, Natural Resources Wales has varied Table 1.1 of the permit to include limits which the operator must operate below to remain a waste facility, resulting from the introduction of the Industrial Emissions Directive.

The site technically has the capacity to operate above the threshold limits detailed within the IED for the following activities:

- 5.6A (1) (a) Temporary storage of hazardous waste with a total capacity exceeding 50 tonnes.

However, they have chosen to put physical measures in place to operate below the thresholds to remain permitted as a waste facility. Therefore, Natural Resources Wales has included these physical limits within the permit to incorporate them as an enforceable permit condition.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

Specified Waste Management Operation	Permitted Waste Types which may be subject to the Specified Operation	Limits on Specified Waste Management Operations
R3: Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents, including composting and other biological transformation processes	All Wastes	Only manual treatment and pre-treatment of waste electrical and electronic equipment [WEEE] (including waste electrical and electronic equipment containing ozone depleting substances [ODS-WEEE]) is permitted and shall be undertaken on impermeable pavement provided in accordance with condition 2.1.
R4: Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds		Destruction of waste electrical and electronic equipment carcasses containing ozone depleting substances shall be undertaken in a contained environment.
R5: Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic compounds		Treatment consisting of sorting, dismantling, separation, shredding, screening, grading, baling, shearing, compacting, crushing, granulation, or cutting of waste into different components for recovery. Treatment includes the repair and refurbishment of WEEE. The capacity of the site for hazardous waste subject to a R5 activity shall not exceed 10 tonnes per day.

R13: Storage of wastes pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced) D15: Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced)	All Wastes	Storage prior to pre-treatment of WEEE and ODS-WEEE shall be undertaken on impermeable pavement provided in accordance with condition 2.1 Free storage shall not exceed a maximum storage height of 3.5 metres or 2 units high Palletised or racked storage - individual storage shall not exceed a maximum height of 5 metres high per pallet or shelf WEEE, disassembled spare parts, components or residues must be stored on an impermeable surface disassembled spare parts containing liquids shall be stored in appropriate containers Batteries, PCBs/PCTs containing capacitors and other hazardous wastes must be stored in dedicated, labelled appropriate containers. The capacity of the site for non-hazardous waste subject to a D13 activity only (i.e. treatment for disposal in shredders of metal waste, including waste electrical and electronic equipment and end-of-life vehicles and their components) shall not exceed 50 tonnes per day. The capacity of the site for non-hazardous waste subject to a R13 and D13 activity (i.e. treatment for recovery or a mix of recovery and disposal) in shredders of metal waste, including waste electrical and electronic equipment and end-of-life vehicles and their components) shall not exceed 75 tonnes per day. Temporary storage of hazardous waste, pending any of the activities listed in Sections 5.1, 5.2 and 5.3 of the environmental permitting regulations shall not exceed a total capacity of 50 tonnes. This includes any underground storage of hazardous waste but does not include temporary storage pending collection of waste generated on site.

Schedule 3 – conditions to be added

None
