Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the permit

The following notice, which is issued pursuant to regulation 20 and Part 1 of Schedule 5 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 S.I.2010 No. 675 (the Regulations), gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit to operate a regulated facility.

This variation increases the annual throughput to no more than 75,000 tonnes per annum and increase the storage capacity of certain waste streams.

- 1.1.1 No waste management operations shall be authorised by this licence unless: specified in and undertaken in accordance with the following the table; or otherwise required by the conditions of this licence as being an integral part of these operations;
