NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE

WHEREAS on 11 November 1996 the Environment Agency granted to you a Waste Management Licence Reference Number SEW/201 relating to Yffaldau, Llandegley, Llandrindod Wells, Powys subject to the conditions set out therein and in any subsequent Modifications.

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that the Environment Agency ("the Agency") modifies the said conditions as follows:-

The following Conditions attached to Waste Management Licence Reference Number SEW/201 shall be deleted,

Condition Number(s): E17 and E18

and the attached Conditions, Waste Management Licence Reference Number SEW/201 shall be substituted:

New Condition No: E17

E17.1 A record shall be kept of all wastes received (other than those wastes delivered by private householders) and of all materials (wastes and recovered materials) removed from the site. The records shall include the following for each vehicle load of waste/material.

for waste received

- (a) origin of waste
- (b) date received
- (c) quantities in tonnes received and waste type as specified in Condition No: B1, Schedule B
- (d) nature of the waste (solid, liquid or sludge)

for waste/material removed

- (e) date removed
- (f) quantities in tonnes removed and waste and/or material type
- (g) destination of waste and/or materials removed
- (h) nature of the waste and/or materials (solid, liquid or sludge)

E17.2 A summary of the information, including nil returns shall be submitted to the Agency, in a format required by the Agency. Summaries shall be for each quarter of the financial year and shall be submitted to the Agency within one month of the end of each quarter.





New Condition No 18.1, Schedule E

E18.1 A record shall be kept detailing all materials recycled or reclaimed on site.

New Condition No 18.2, Schedule E

E18.2 All records required to be kept under condition 17.1 and 18.1, Schedule E of this licence must be made available to any authorised representative of the Environment Agency for inspection at any reasonable time.

Such modification shall take effect on 31 March 1999 at 24.00 hours.
